### ST. PAUL'S FIRST LUTHERAN SCHOOL MISSION STATEMENT

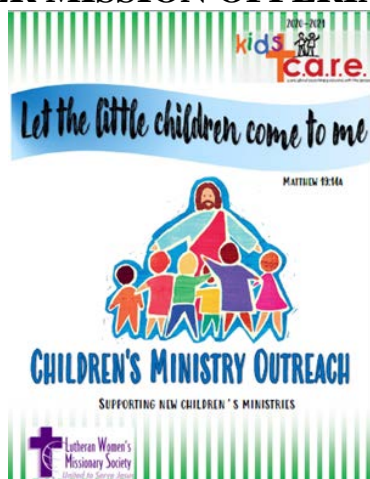
St. Paul's First Lutheran School assists families and children building excellent spiritual, moral and academic foundations for life, and producing life-long learners centered in Christ.
